The image slam is a chance for the whole community to see the work of a variety of local artists—including yours—on a giant 20 ft. outdoor screen at Moore Square Park.

Each artist can submit up to 3 digital images of artwork. At least 1 image from each artist will be included, assuming all criteria are met. Images and artist credit will be continuously looped during SPARK CON, Saturday night, September 22.

- Send up to 3 images of your work
- **Submit on CD (will not be returned)**
- **Resolution minimum: 144 dpi in 1024 x 768. Any image that does not meet the minimum resolution will not be displayed.**
- Include your name and contact information
- Accepted work will be credited

Show off your creativity onstage in a supportive environment reserved only for teens. Your imagination is the only limit!

Submit your ideas to us in writing by filling out our registration form and describing your performance in about 25 words.

Rules For Entry

- Participants must be between 13 and 18 years of age.
- Must have a completed registration form signed by parent/guardian.
- Performance must be between 2-10 minutes in length.
- Acts must be appropriate for a teen audience.
- All entries and performances must be original works that you created, for example: no lip-syncing or reciting Shakespeare.

OPEN ART EXHIBITION

Vintage 21, co-hosted by Artspace and the Contemporary Art Museum, will be hosting the largest Open Art Exhibition in the Triangle during SPARK CON.

Whats the coolest part about this? We are setting aside room for art created by teens like you! You can submit original art, photography, design and sculpture to be displayed until the end of October.

Opens Thursday, September 20, SPARK CON's kickoff. Artists will have a second reception on "First Friday," October 5.

- Registration paperwork must be submitted with artwork, and will be available at www.vintage21.com or on the SPARK CON site
- **Artwork is due W. 9/12 and Th. 9/13**
- **First come, first serve, until we run out of room!**
- **\$5 entry fee (1 entry only per artist)**
- All work must be ready to hang and artists must participate in hanging their own artwork
- Artwork no larger than 72" x 72" and no more than 100 lbs.
- Sculpture accepted on a limited basis. Artists must provide pedestal for sculptures.
- Sales handled by artists (no commission taken).
